

WHAT TO DO NEXT:

Get your soil or forage analysed

- Send 3 soils samples in the bags provided, which represent different areas of your farm.
- PLUS a grass or silage/hay sample from this year's forage.
- Send them to us in the reply paid bag enclosed herewith.

These samples will be sent to specialist laboratories and it will take up to two weeks to get the results back.

When the results are received we will forward the information to you, together with our recommendations for discussion. We will also enclose our invoice for £347 plus VAT, which if you approve the results and recommendations you will be pleased to pay.

An example of the Soil Analysis is included within this booklet and you can see how comprehensive this is – it is this information which allows us to make recommendations to you to improve your soil's true fertility at low cost.

The grass/forage analysis will allow me to make recommendations on what can be done to balance the minerals and improve grass quality.

It is the minerals in the grass that directly affects your stocks' health and wellbeing.

They cannot make the vitamins if the minerals are not there i.e.

- Vitamin B¹² requires cobalt (So do the nitrogen fixing organisms)
- Too low cobalt means poor nitrogen utilisation
